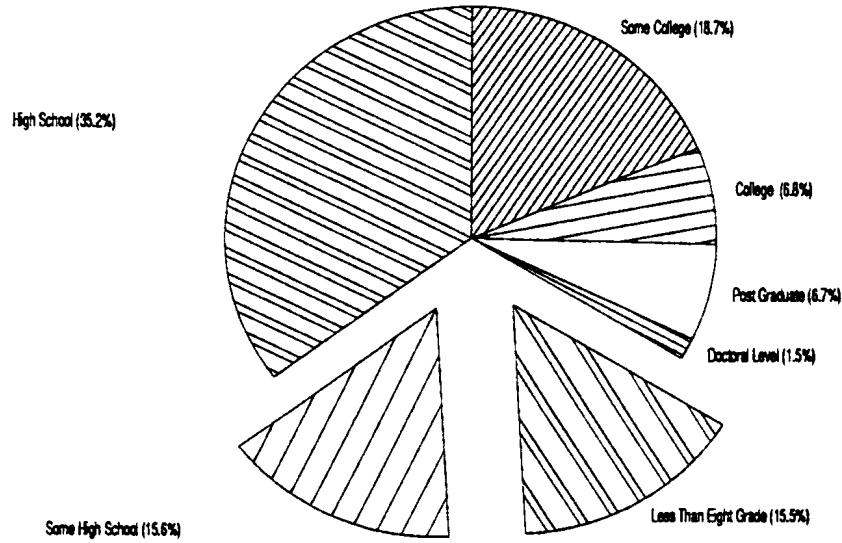


Figure 2. New York State

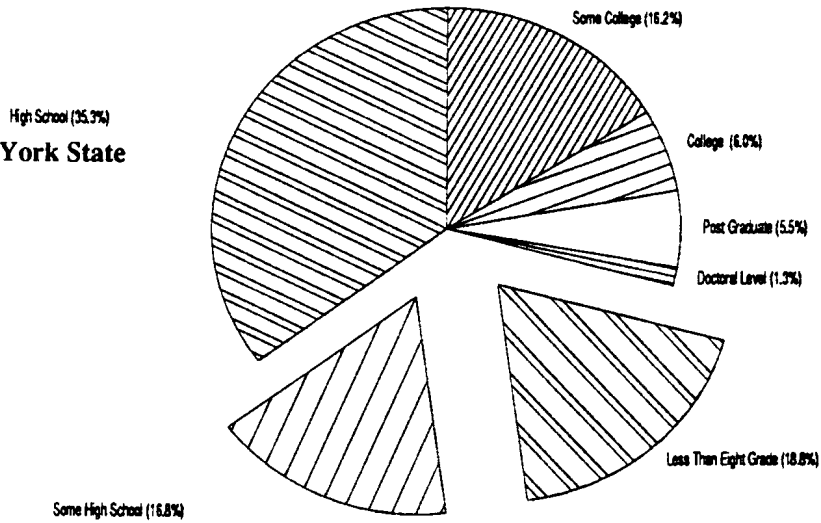
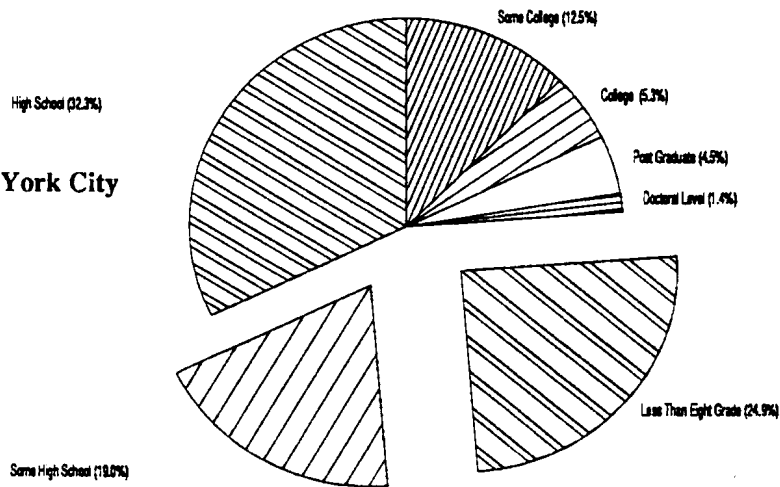


Figure 3. New York City

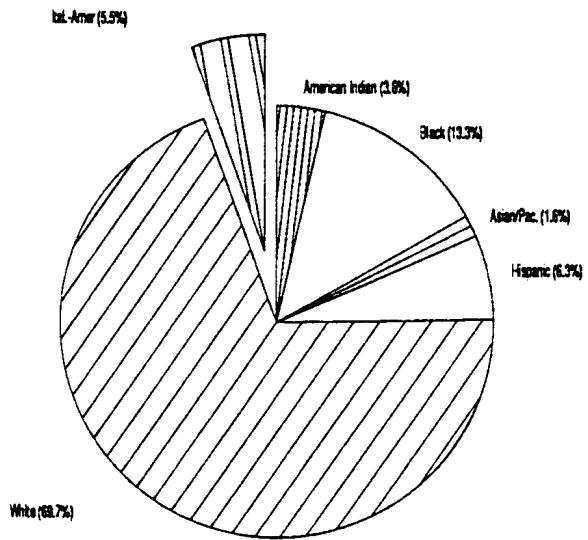


Figure 5. New York State

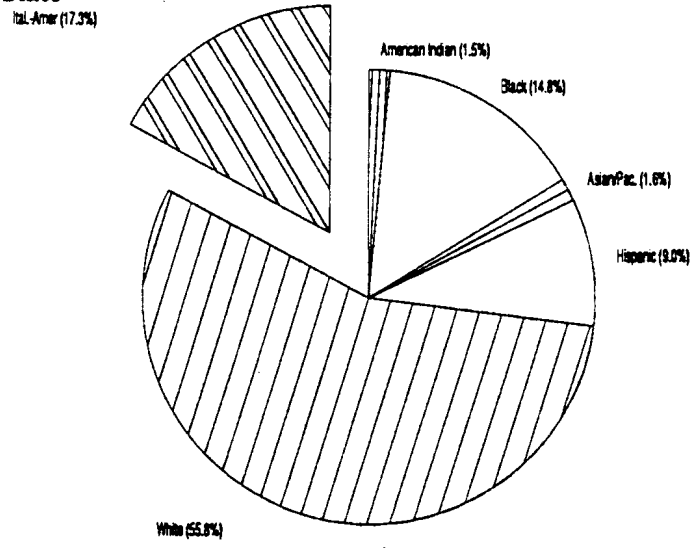
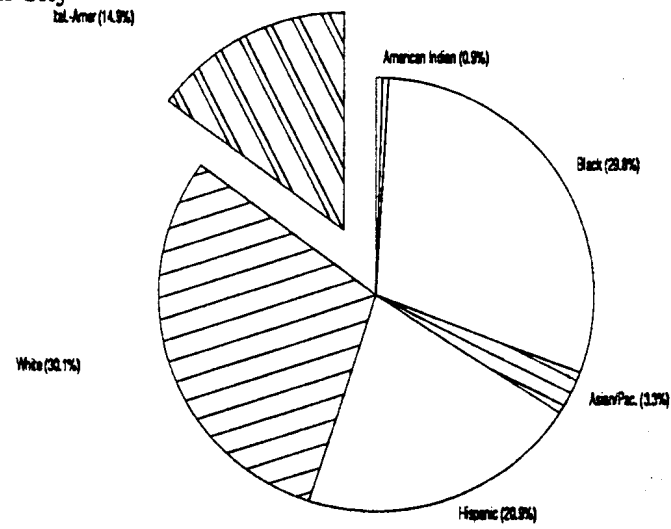


Figure 6. New York City

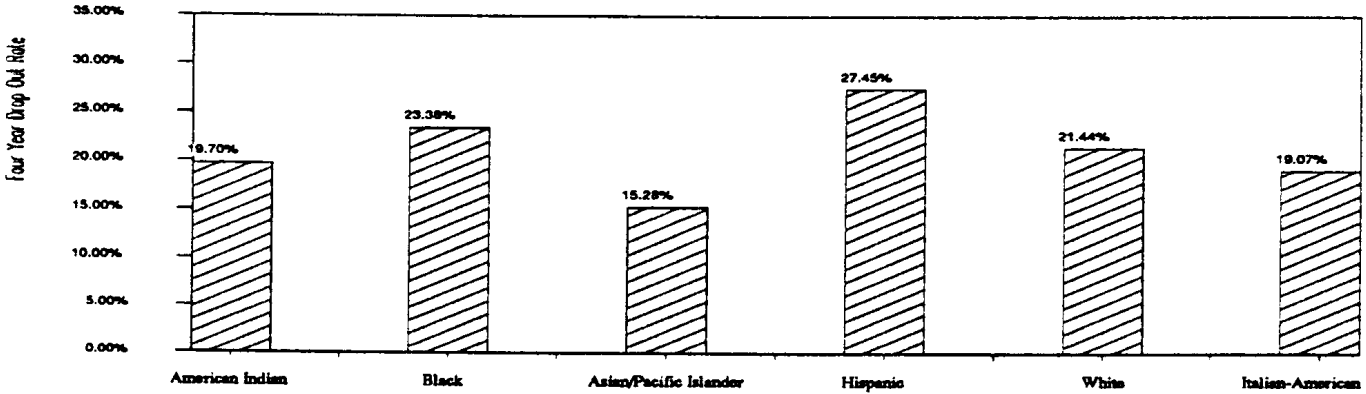


Figure 8. New York State

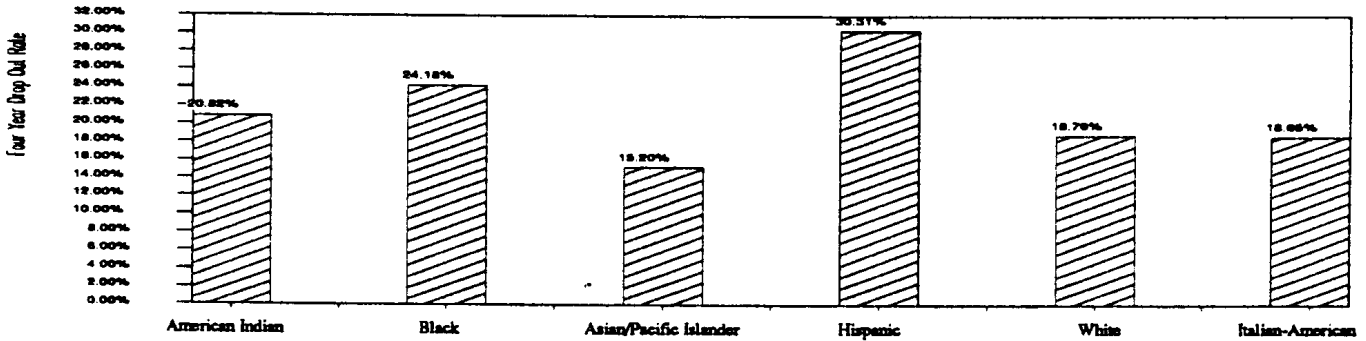
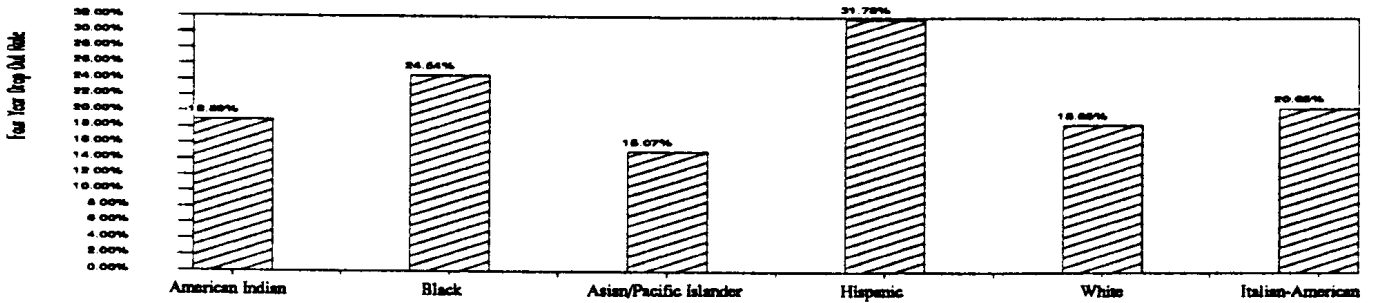


Figure 9. New York City

Figure 10. By Family Income

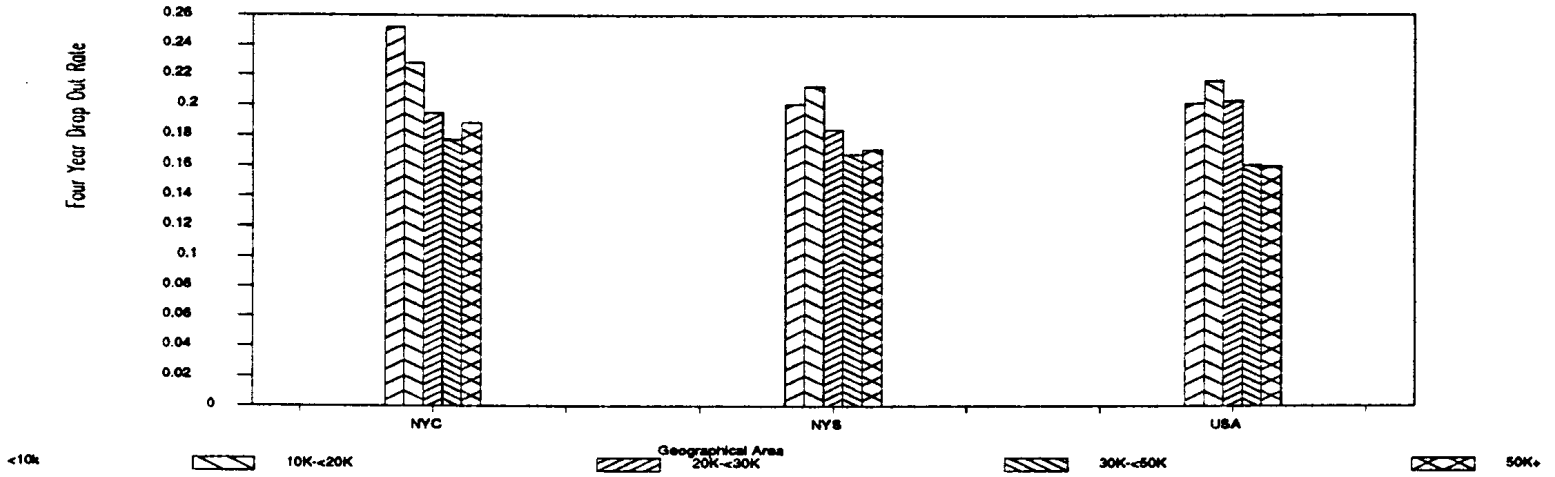


Figure 11. By Head of Household Education

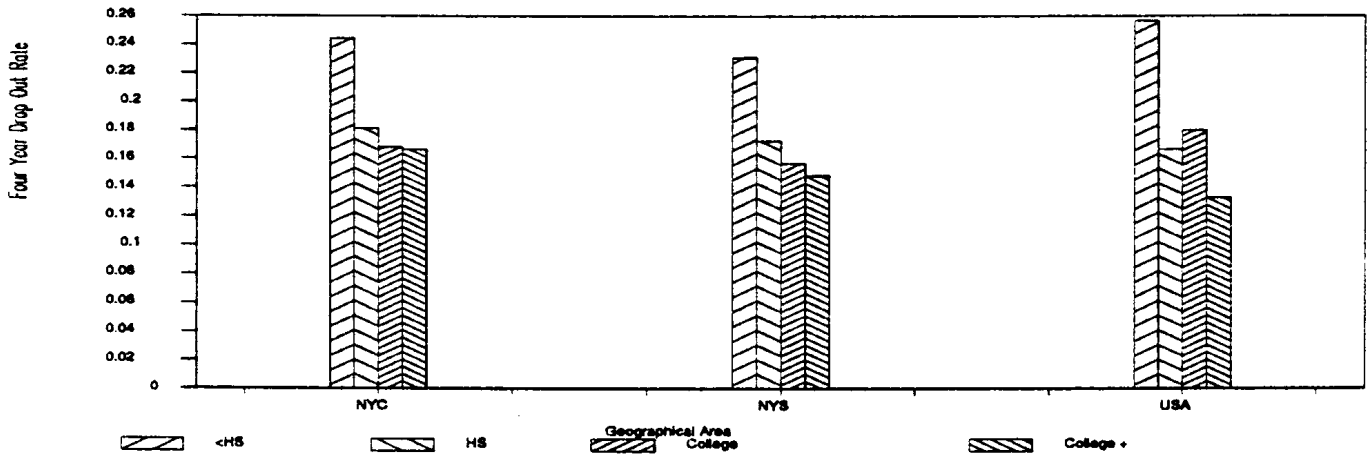
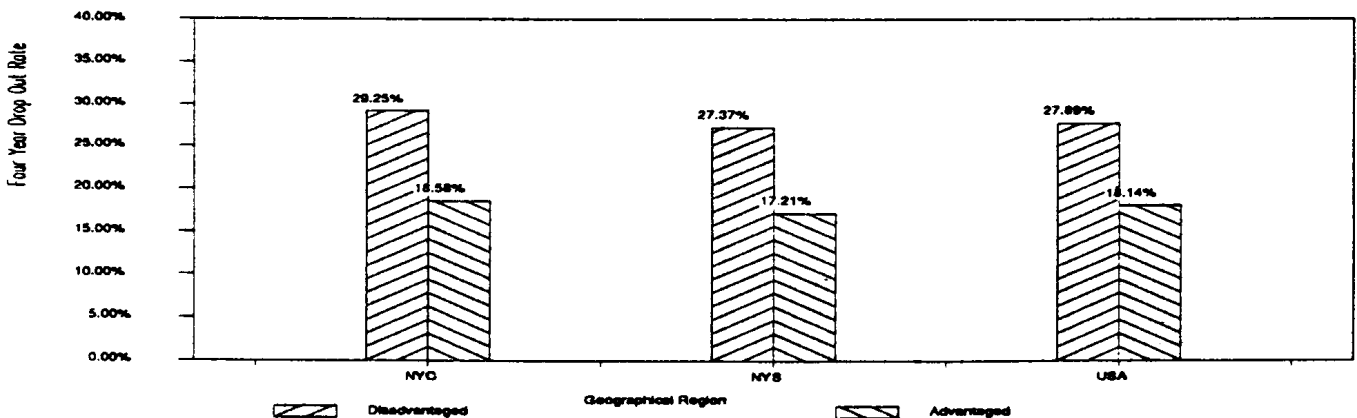


Figure 12. Disadvantage vs. Advantage

Figure 13. By Gender

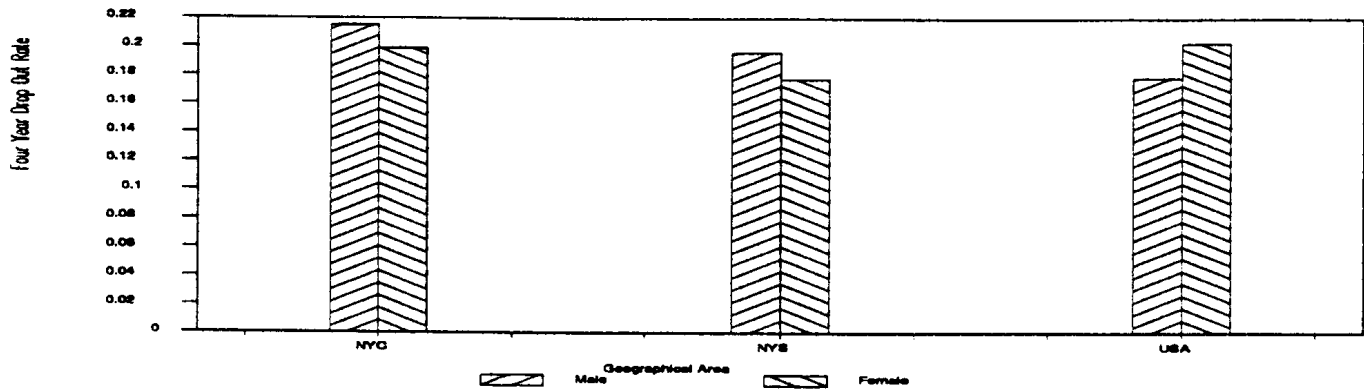


Figure 14. By Student Generation

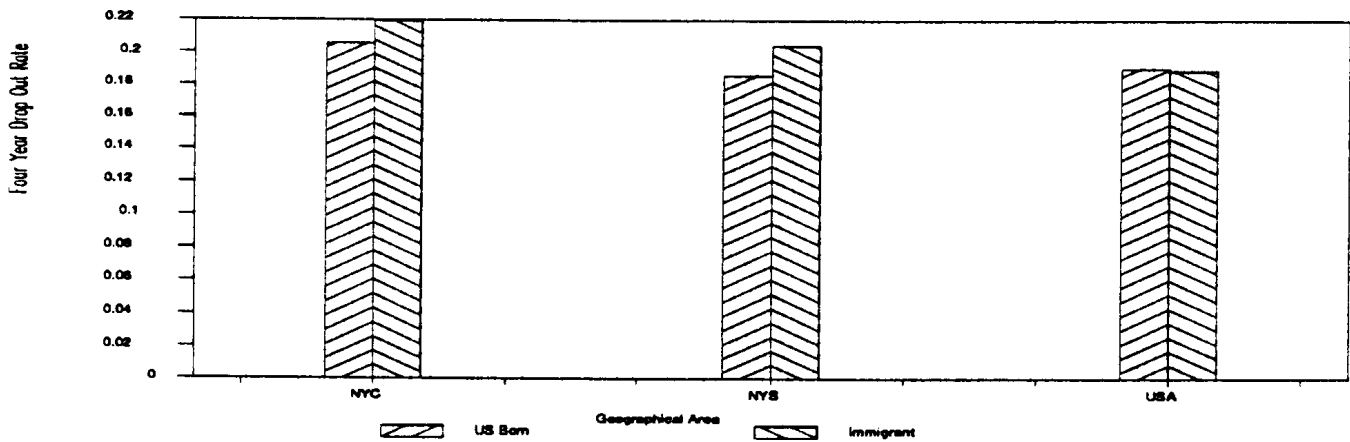


Figure 15. By Head of Household Generation
